ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

India has large variation in climate due to its vast range of altitude and physiographic features. Indian tropical vegetation comprises tropical rain forest, tropical semi evergreen, tropical deciduous forest and grasslands that harbor rich plant diversity, ranging from cryptogams to variety of angiospermic plants. The vast biodiversity of tropical region is yet to be explored. Many tropical wild plants have cultural and social value and are extensively used by the tribals in a variety of ways. Their proper documentation, indexing, habitat preference and the study of community characteristics is needed. The nutritive and medicinal potential of large number of plants is well known, but the wealth of the tropical plant diversity is still largely unexplored. Thus, the time has come to move towards a new era for improving and improvising ways to attain sustainability through conservation of our bio resources and working for human welfare at the same time. The present Conference focuses on recent researches on distribution, with specialization of various uses of tropical, especially the wild and less known plant species for the human welfare.
